

## CARE & USE

### DRY ERASE PORCELAIN ENAMEL MARKING BOARDS

An initial cleaning of your MARKERBOARD should be performed to ensure no residual film or abrasive residue are present to damage the surface.

#### PROPER USAGE:

1. ERASE YOUR BOARD with a soft cloth or felt eraser of #2 quality or better.
2. WRITE on your board with specially formulated DRY ERASE MARKERS designed for specific purpose.
3. WASH your board periodically to eliminate problems from built up dust, grease, and other contaminants.

#### CLEANING & MAINTENANCE:

**WASH** your board with any liquid ammonia-added cleaner.

DO NOT attempt to use abrasive or polishing cleaner.

Basic window cleaner (Steer clear of streak-free or Vinegar added etc.)

**RINSE** with clear water and **DRY** your board with a soft towel.

A sponge and squeegee will work great, and are much easier for large boards.

100% Cotton towels or rags are a cheap solution.

REMEMBER that the writing surface is PORCELAIN. Like GLASS it will chip and craze if subjected to improper handling. ALSO like glass, the surface is impervious to chemical attack, so DO NOT PANIC if someone writes with permanent marker, crayon, pen, etc.. These stains, and tape adhesive residue can be cleaned using the method above.

For stubborn residue, use a mild solvent or a paste made from scouring powder and water. Gently work on your stain in a circular motion.

For permanent markings, write directly over-top of the permanent markings with a dry erase marker. Allow time to soak in & erase.
